	<i>The WVLS Board of Trustees shall establish the policy framework within which V-Cat functions and shall annually budget funds for its own V-Cat membership as well as funds to support the continued development of V-Cat and to encourage area libraries to join V-Cat. The V-Cat Council shall establish operational procedures for V-Cat.</i>
