## **Using Google Cardboard**

- 1. Find a seat. You might be inclined to walk around while using Google Cardboard glasses without considering the furniture in the physical room you are using the device in.
- 2. Follow the directions on your Google Cardboard to fold the cardboard into your glasses.
- 3. Using any smartphone, download the free <u>Google</u> Cardboard app.
- 4. Open the Google Cardboard app.
- 5. When prompted, scan the QR code on your Google Cardboard glasses. The QR code looks like a black square filled with pixels.
- 6. Insert your phone into the phone slot in the back of the Google Cardboard glasses.
- 7. Look into the eyeholes and enjoy!
- 8. The button on the top right of the device is your "mouse," lightly press down on the button to click on functions within the virtual world.
