#### L.E.N.A Update

We are starting to get into the training modules. We've added two of our professional staff Taylor W and Laura L. Both have shown keen interest in working with young children and the developmental parts of the process. We are still trying to wrap up the last bit of funding. The anticipated start date is in February.

#### Martin Luther King "Day On" Update

The next Library Board of Trustees meeting is scheduled for January 15. This is also the day that the County Board has asked we all recognize Martin Luther King, Jr. day as a day of inservice for staff. Since we are not emergency personnel, Mr. Karger has asked me to ask the Library Board of Trustees to approve January 15 an in-service day. This will aligned us with what other county departments and agencies are doing. Because this is new for the county, we are still planning on having our staff development day in September. We will try and make our day more library specific.
