

### 1. Update on PLSR Preliminary Model Frameworks

Two preliminary model frameworks have been made available on the PLSR website and are now available for public comment. An update was posted on July 2:

Russell Consulting, Inc., the model development facilitators, are working with a small team to format the content of the two models in a consistent manner and fill in gaps. This work won't change the basic model concepts but will make it easier to compare. This should occur later in the comment period so you may wish to delay responding.
