

% of books **about** Africans/African Americans that were also **by** Africans/African Americans









Examples of Additional 2018 Stats

- Type of character
 - Human: 2,379
 - Animal: 716
 - Examples: 70 dogs; 56 bears; 48 cats; 36 birds; 21 dinosaurs; 14 monkeys; 1 badger, etc.
 - More than twice as many dog primary characters as Indigenous primary characters
 - Other: 230
 - Examples: 25 monsters; 18 fairies; 9 trucks; 1 tomato; 1 potato, etc.
