- WVLS will be making a switch in OverDrive on Tuesday, May 23 to make it easier when
 patrons get a replacement library card number. OverDrive will use the patron record number for
 identification instead of the patron barcode. Staff will no longer need to merge barcodes for
 patrons in OverDrive when a new barcode is issued to an existing patron.
 - After this change occurs, some patrons may need to perform a validation of their credentials and type in their PIN again. Your library staff may receive an increased number of patrons reporting credential issues.
- Due to Memorial Day, WVLS will be closed on Monday, May 29. Delivery service will not run
 on this day, and it will resume on Tuesday, May 30. "Monday Mentions" will be posted on
 Tuesday, May 30 at 12 p.m.

It's time for school libraries to suspend lending in WISCAT. This will ensure that materials will be back to public libraries before the end of the school year. Suspending your library's lending is easy to do using the

Holiday List, located in your Participant Record. To update your Participant Record with a "Holiday," log in to your WISCAT staff account and do the following:

- Click Staff Dashboard to access the administrative modules
- Under the ILL Admin menu choose Participant Record
- Click the Holiday List link at the top of the page or scroll down to that section
- Enter the Start and End dates using the format MM/DD/YYYY
- Click the Submit button at the top right or bottom right of the record
