

- 1. If a patron brings an item to the check-out area and, when scanned, a notice that a different patron has a hold on the item appears, it <u>is</u> appropriate to override in order to check out the item to the patron who is present.
- 2. When renewing an item, a library will NOT override an alert for an item owned by another library.
- 3. Libraries will respect one another's fines and charges on a patron record and will NOT override the threshold of fine level set by the check-out library.
- 4. Once a library's item has been classified as high demand, another library will NOT override a "not holdable by patron" block on that library's high demand. (see **High Demand Items**)
- 5. Libraries will respect one another's limitations on the total number of items a patron may check out, and the number of items by type that a patron may check out. Libraries will not override a "maximum checkouts" patron block for patrons of other libraries.

Explanation

Patron blocks may be set in Sierra for temporary patrons or for patrons of a specific library. These blocks are enforced by Sierra based on the patron type and are applied for circulation activity regardless checkout library.
