PANCAKE ART KIT

Pancake art is a fun and creative activity where designs are created on a griddle using pancake batter as the medium. Squeeze bottles are used to apply the batter, allowing designers to outline shapes, create patterns, and experiment with different designs. The final image is revealed when the pancake is flipped over, making it a fun and delicious way to showcase creativity!

Kit includes: 2 Presto 07047 cool touch griddles (with power cords), 2 Large Silicone turners, 5 easy squeeze bottles, 8 one oz. bottles with 4 tips, 8 assorted gel food colors, 1 measuring cup
