### Split Blu-ray/DVD combo update

The instructions for splitting Blu-ray/DVD combo packs into separate bibs are being revised to make them work better with Aspen.

#### Easy reader boxed sets keyword search

Easy reader boxed sets are more easily searchable by keyword with the addition of a local subject heading to the bib record: **Subject 690 \_ 7 Easy reader boxed sets.**|2local Interested libraries can ask Rachel for more information.

#### **ISNI numbers/WorldCat Entities**

As these numbers may have future usefulness in linked data and do not create display issues in Aspen or Sierra, we will retain them.

#### 979 ISBN prefix

ISBNs with a 979 prefix do not have a 10-digit equivalent. Nevertheless, these "false equivalent" 10-digit ISBNs have come into our catalog (one possible source: vendor records) and may potentially causes issues. The committee is investigating and creating a plan to deal with them.

#### Aspen updates

- "Force re-index" function improved.
- Aspen can be slow to update when a large number of records are being edited at once. Report issues lasting more than a few minutes to <u>help@librarieswin.org</u>
- In Staff View, click "Diagnostics" to see why Aspen chose to assign the format it did. ("bib level format Book based on 300 Physical Description" . . . "based on Leader" . . .)
- Aspen sandbox is set up and instructions are forthcoming.
- Saved searches retained only 24 hours.
- Alternate titles and authors if you see errors, please report them.
- Aspen is stripping [graphic novel] from titles and now has a "Manga" label separate from "Graphic Novel".
- Subject searches with punctuation now work.
- Aspen introduced an Accesible Layout Browse Category option to increase accessibility for users who
  navigate with a keyboard instead of a mouse. Not enabled on V-Cat library sites yet will be tested on
  Aspen test site.
