2) Schedule "Tally Week" in October

Have you scheduled your library's annual survey week this October to collect data for the public library annual report? The annual report requires an annual count of reference transactions, library visits and use of-public computers. However, if a library is not able to maintain an annual count for any of these data elements, it is recommended that the library do a tally during a "typical" week or weeks, and then multiply the count to make an annual estimate.
