### **♦ LIBBY TIP: SAMPLE**

The Libby app allows users to sample up to 10% of any ebook or audiobook in their library's digital collection, even if the title is currently borrowed by another user. This feature is useful for deciding which titles to borrow, or to start reading a title while waiting for it to become available. To sample, tap on the book's jacket cover, then select "play sample" or "read sample."

# INCLUSIVE SERVICES

### **EDI & ANTIRACISM TOOLKIT**

This toolkit from the Oregon Library Association is a comprehensive resource designed to help libraries reflect on and improve their institutional practices and policies. It provides guidance on creating inclusive environments that respect and celebrate diverse identities and experiences. The toolkit includes practical strategies for addressing systemic inequities, fostering antiracist practices, and promoting social justice within library services. It also offers tools for staff training, community engagement, and policy development to ensure libraries can effectively serve all members of their communities.

### O TALES & TRAVEL TOOLKIT

This comprehensive resource is designed to assist librarians in creating meaningful and engaging programs for individuals with dementia. It offers a variety of tools, including detailed sample agendas, curated bibliographies, and a range of creative resources. # MORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

### **WISCONNECT**

WisConnect is a platform developed by Wisconsin's Department of Workforce Development to connect college students with internship opportunities across the state. It allows students to create professional profiles, upload resumes, and search for internships that match their skills and career goals. Employers can also use WisConnect to post internships, search for potential interns, and access resources to build or expand their internship programs. It's a valuable resource for students looking to gain practical experience and for businesses aiming to develop a skilled talent pipeline.

### **WI YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP**

This program offers high school juniors and seniors the chance to gain hands-on experience in their chosen career fields while still in school. This one- or two-year program combines classroom instruction with paid work experience, covering 16 broad career areas such as Health Sciences, Information Technology, and Manufacturing. Students receive on-the-job training from mentors, complemented by related coursework, ensuring they gain both theoretical and practical knowledge. Upon completion, participants earn an industry-recognized certificate, enhancing their resumes and college applications.
