Sierra Upgrades

Two Sierra upgrades have been released since the V-Cat ILS Evaluation and Review Committee wrapped up their work in 2023. Sierra 6.3 will be released by the end of 2024. Sierra 6.1

(This upgrade was released in December 2023. V-Cat has not upgraded to this release due to concerns about known issues with patron notices and search functions.)

Sierra 6.2

(This upgrade was released in June 2024 and requires an upgraded server. V-Cat will need to migrate to a new upgraded server or migration to Innovative cloud hosting.)

Sierra 6.3

(In beta testing. To be released fourth quarter 2024.)

Full release notes cannot be shared in public meeting documents, but can be provided to V-Cat member library staff upon request.

Sierra Cloud Hosting

Innovative has included cloud hosting in the current quote. A migration to cloud hosting would mean that the Sierra application and database would be hosted on virtual severs managed by Innovative instead of on LeanWI managed servers in the shared data center. Innovative would manage updates, security, and backups.

Sierra Test Server

Innovative has included a test server in the current quote. This would allow ILS Administration staff to test out planned upgrades and changes to global and library specific settings without impacting the day to day workflows of library staff.
