5) Post-COVID Survey Request

Although we are some distance away from the peak of COVID-19, limited research has been conducted into how public libraries altered their services during the pandemic, as well as what service changes have remained permanent and what changes were just temporary to accommodate patron needs when physical access to library buildings was restricted.

Brian Real, Assistant Professor at the University of Kentucky's School of Information Science is <u>conducting a survey</u> about how library services have changed in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. The survey takes about 15 minutes to complete and is available through January 10.
