

1) Delivery Service Update

WVLS was notified in early February that the Waltco hubs in Wausau and Eau Claire would be closing at the end of the month. This meant that WVLS and the IFLS Library System needed to find new vendors to operate courier for its member libraries.

- Week of February 10: WVLS member libraries were notified and WVLS staff met with three delivery vendors.
- Week of February 17: WVLS assessed delivery vendors ability and capacity to do deliveries as libraries have come to expect. Purple Mountain Solutions was selected as the vendor best able to fulfill our goals for service.
- Week of February 24: This is the final week of service with Waltco. WVLS is working with Waltco staff on getting all library keys returned to WVLS.

The new vendor, Purple Mountain Solutions, will begin service the week of March 3. While days of delivery will be the same, we anticipate that delivery times might vary. Please be patient with WVLS and with the Purple Mountain team as this new service is implemented.

For Makerspace and Equipment Kits: Please add at least two business days to the start and end of bookings for kits from outside WVLS to account for longer delivery times.

Similar to Waltco, WVLS will manage the services provided through Purple Mountain on behalf of our libraries. Any communications and concerns about deliveries should be addressed to <u>courier@wvls.org</u>.
